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PINK SANDS RESORT, HARBOUR ISLAND, BAHAMAS

DESIGN APPEAL British Colonial charm meets splendor at the Pink Sands Resort, a 64-year-old family-run resort on the Bahamas' Harbour Island now undergoing an extensive refurbishment. Under the watchful eye of interior designer David Flint Wood, the legendary resort's luxury villas will be reborn as private residences with breathtaking views of the 3 ½-mile pink-sand beach, one of the most beautiful in the world. Revamped interiors will feature dark hardwood floors, plantation shutters and British West Indies-style furniture, accented by pale greens, sea-foam blues and flowing ivory white linen curtains reinforcing the effortless island cool that has defined the resort for six decades.

INSIDE SCOOP The rich and famous (celebs like Kate Moss and Keith Richards are among past guests) lead quiet, secluded lives at Harbour Island. Nestled into the lush gardens of an official bird sanctuary, this development offers resort amenities such as a freshwater swimming pool, tennis courts, kayaks, paddleboards and massage services. Far from any urban center, Pink Sands Harbour Island is just steps from local boutiques and casual restaurants.
